

Similarly, research in Clinical Dermatology (Barry, 2001) confirms that skin hydration is a key factor in enhancing transdermal drug delivery. **Tip:** Advise patients to gently pat the skin dry (leaving it slightly damp) before applying their topical medication, and consider short-term occlusion

for Hyperkeratotic tissue(e.g., with plastic wrap) when clinically appropriate.



Why Drugs in Solution Often Work Better Than Drugs in Suspension


